

CARRIBEAN ISLANDS INCREASES ROI BY ADDING SECURITY TO SERVICES

A telecommunications provider in the Carribean Islands is decreasing its rate of payback of the fibre optic network it has installed on the island to be one of the first in the region to provide CCTV to its governmental and business customers.

The telecommunications provider in Aruba, Setar N.V., had 250 existing cameras on their headquarters and were requiring a robust surveillance application to manage the existing security infrastructure which would handle both the large number of cameras and allow expansion in the future.

8 x 32ch Eyesoft licences were supplied preinstalled on industrial grade BiKal NVR's to accommodate the existing cameras. The software application allowed us to build a distributed storage system helping manage load & redundancy across a number of NVR's. The simplified user interface of Eyesoft allowed the customer to manage all 250 cameras with ease and respond to live events via the live video pop-up alarm feature. Since installation, a further 50 cameras were added made simple by just plugging in an additional NVR to the network.

The result was a highly robust surveillance system that was easy to manage and expand. The customer also commented on how they saved money with the software's low pricing structure allowing him to only purchase the features he required with an option to add modules such as analytics or additional cameras at any time.
